GIT INSTALLTION

1. Mac:

To find out if git is already installed in your system, open a terminal and enter `git --version`.

```
$ git --version
```

Install using Mac Installer

1. Download the latest Git for [Mac installer](#).
2. Once you complete the process, check if it was installed successfully or not.

Install git with Homebrew

If you have installed [Homebrew](#) to manage packages on OS X, you can follow these instructions to install Git:

Step 1: Open your terminal and install Git using Homebrew:

```
$ brew install git
```

Step 3 Check if it was installed successfully or not.

```
$ git --version
```

Install Git with MacPorts

If you have [installed MacPorts](#) to manage packages on OS X, you can follow these instructions to install Git:

Step 1: Open your terminal and update MacPorts:

```
$ sudo port selfupdate
```

Step 3: Search for the latest available Git ports and variants:

```
$ port search git  
$ port variants git
```

Step 3: Install Git with bash completion, the OS X keychain helper, and the docs:

```
$ sudo port install git +bash_completion+credential_osxkeychain+doc
```
